- Because I am a member of **CCAE**, my voice is strengthened when combined with over three thousand members state-wide.
- **CCAE** is the only organization that includes teachers, classified employees, administrators, counselors, and coordinators of adult education.
- Established in 1943, **CCAE** has won the respect of elected officials, legislators, governmental agencies, and appointed officials.
- **CCAE** sponsors legislation, through supportive State Legislators, and actively works for the passage of these bills.
- The **CCAE** Lobbyist, Jeff Frost, and our representatives meet on a regular basis with other adult education groups to provide a united front.

- **CCAE** activities and events are excellent venues for networking and sharing information with other adult educators throughout the state.

- The Adult Ed Administrator from CDE regularly attends the **CCAE** State Board meeting and State and Section Conferences, where there is an open flow of ideas between **CCAE** and CDE.
